

Flag Signals

1. No Flag Signal: All Clear	
2. Yellow Flag held motionless: <u>Danger</u> <u>Slow Down</u> <u>Overtaking forbidden</u>	
3. Yellow Flag waved: <u>Danger</u> <u>Slow Down</u> <u>Overtaking Forbidden</u> <u>Prepare to STOP</u> <i>Generally a waved yellow flag will be preceded by a stationary yellow flag</i>	
4. Red Flag: <u>Stop racing and proceed slowly to the paddock only on Instruction from clerk of the course.</u>	
5. Yellow Flag with Red Stripes: <u>Warning of Slippery Surface</u> (e.g. oil)	
6. Black Flag displayed with a number (usually on a blackboard): <u>Competitor bearing that number should stop with the utmost care and attention</u>	
7. White Flag: Warning -- Official Vehicle on circuit	
8. Other Flag Signals Start of Race: National Flag Finish of Race: Chequered Flag Last Lap Flag
